

# TEMPORARY MODULAR HOUSING

## A PARCEL OF LAND ON THE LITTLE MOUNTAIN DEVELOPMENT SITE HAS BEEN IDENTIFIED AS A POTENTIAL SITE FOR TEMPORARY MODULAR HOUSING

The City of Vancouver, in partnership with the Vancouver Affordable Housing Agency (VAHA) and BC Housing, is building temporary modular housing on various sites across the city to create much-needed housing for homeless people.

A parcel located at Little Mountain is available for temporary modular housing. The building would be three storeys and contain approximately 50 single-studio homes. The building would be in place for approximately 3 years and would be staffed 24/7, by an experienced non-profit housing operator.

The housing would not delay or impact the delivery of the permanent social housing units planned for the same parcel at the Little Mountain development.

## HOW YOU CAN LEARN MORE

- The project partners will hold a Community Information Session to answer questions, and listen to the community's feedback on the proposed project.
- Staff will conduct walkabouts to connect with residents and businesses.
- Input will be considered by the Director of Planning when deciding on a development permit for the project.
